Additionally, the RND Division leads technical dialogue and development of knowledge products on these topics.

## **What You Will Do:**

The main objective of this consultancy is to provide technical and administrative assistance in various activities relating to collaborative programs with Korea. The selected candidate is also expected to participate in knowledge creation and/or operational activities, including the design, execution, monitoring, and reporting of RND projects.

The main responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Support the design, execution, monitoring, and reporting of investment, grants, and technical assistance projects.
- Engage in knowledge sharing to further strengthen ongoing collaboration in RND areas between Korea and the IDB.
- Work with RND staff and government counterparts in LAC on IDB projects that could/are receiving technical and/or financial support from the Korean government.
- Support and participate in meetings and/or workshops to promote collaboration between Korea and the IDB.
- Identify and engage in the development of knowledge products.
